APPLETON, Wis. — Thanks to dedicated individuals working with Old Glory Honor Flight, World War II veterans have the opportunity to take a day trip to Washington, D.C. and visit many of the nation's war memorials. On Monday, July 19 at 1:30 p.m., Drew MacDonald, president of the organization, will share information about how veterans are honored through this experience.

There is no charge for the event, which will be held at Touchmark on West Prospect, 2601 Touchmark Drive in Appleton.

MacDonald will provide details about the nonprofit organization and how veterans can apply for the flights. Touchmark resident and veteran Bob Scott has participated in an Honor Flight and will share video footage of his experience.

During each Honor Flight, veterans are able to visit memorials dedicated in their honor, including the World War II Memorial, Iwo Jima Memorial, Korean War Memorial, Vietnam War Memorial as well as Arlington National Cemetery. Each flight includes one guardian for every two veterans, and medical staff are available, if required. Wheelchairs and meals are provided.
